



Sport Premium Spending Plan 2018-2019

What is PE & Sport Premium funding?

The PE & Sport Premium is additional government funding aimed at making additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and Sport.

How did the school spend its PE & Sport Premium allocation?

For 2018-2019 Beecholme Primary School will receive £17,666 for the PE & Sports Premium funding.

The table below shows how we are planning to spend our allocation:

Amount allocated	Allocation	How will this support PE and Sport?
£4900	Outdoor Gym Equipment	The new equipment will enable pupils across all key stages to participate in regular outdoor gym sessions to keep fit and learn effectively through movement and exercise.
£1092	Action Mats	Purchasing Action Mats which will enable our Teachers to provide creative and active PE lessons. At Beecholme we wish to engage our pupils in healthy exercise whilst learning through play.
£800	Providing continued swimming for Years 4.	Continued swimming lessons in Year 4 which will result in greater water confidence and an increase in the numbers of children with the ability to swim 25m unaided.
£1550	Additional Booster sessions for Year 6 pupils who cannot swim 25 metres.	This will bring Beecholme in line with National legislation for all Year 6 pupils to be competent swimmers.
£1600	After school clubs and lunchtime activities led by sports coaches and staff	Sports coaches and staff run after school clubs and lunchtime activities to enhance overall skills. This will encourage further participation into competitions in the local Borough and Cluster events. We anticipate additional coaching will enable the pupils to achieve better results as well as feel more confident in the events that they are competing in.
£700	Sports Training and PE Conferences	Our designated PE Teacher will attend training conferences in the Autumn and Summer term to ensure PE is taught at a high standard across all Key Stages.
£4500	MSSP Get Set Specialist Sports provision	Ensure that all staff benefit from regular specialist high quality sports coaching and development. This will enhance skills in all Key Stages enhancing pupil confidence in a variety of sports and activities.
£1300	PE and Sports equipment	New equipment, such as a Netball and Football post, will support and improve the PE curriculum, to ensure that

	(curriculum and active play)	teachers and coaches are well equipped and that children have the necessary resources to benefit fully.
£800	Children involvement in cluster group sports events.	Pupils at Beecholme will continue to participate in local sports festivals and competitions in collaboration with the East Mitcham Cluster. The Sports grant will fund fees and Teacher release.

What was the impact of PE & Sport Premium Spending in 2018/19?

The PE & Sport premium at Beecholme Primary has;

- Increased involvement in Physical Education with the purchase of new outdoor Gym Equipment and Action Mats.



- Encouraged participation in after school clubs such as Various Sports, Football Club and Keep Fit Club, who have incorporated the use of new equipment thus increasing sign up numbers.
- 5-a-day fitness subscriptions have allowed pupils to develop healthy lifestyles through exercise and movement in multiple languages.
- Provided regular swimming sessions enabling pupil confidence in working towards competently swimming 25 metres by the end of KS2. This year being 62%;
- continued training for the PE lead via conferences and training sessions. This has developed the curriculum with effective sessions being planned for Beecholme pupils on a termly basis.
- Beecholme have continued participation with the East Mitcham Cluster and been involved in local and inter-competitions in the Borough. Through hard work and dedication Beecholme have been upgraded to the Gold Mark Award in PE for 2018/19;
- PE curriculum has improved across all Key Stages as pupils learn through play and activity;
- Lunch time activities have benefited from new resources enabling children to keep fit and develop motor and complex skills at break and lunch times with extra activities.
