- The core purpose of Read Write Inc is to teach every child to read and to keep them reading. Children can build an extensive vocabulary and gain new knowledge everyday for themselves. Read write Inc believe children who read a lot do well at school – whatever their background.
- ▶ Their first programme, Read Write Inc. Phonics, is now the market leader in teaching children to read and is used by over a quarter of UK primary schools. It grew out of Ruth Miskin's work as a headteacher in Tower Hamlets. She knew that in order for a school to be successful every headteacher needed to adopt a consistent whole-school approach to teaching reading, writing and spelling.

How It Works

- ► Children are streamed across three year groups, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Currently we have 7 phonics groups. These take place everyday for 30 minutes.
- During these sessions children focus on a sound, a reading book and a writing task.
- Sometimes these sessions depending on the needs of the children.


Resources

- ▶ All these resources are used daily and changed as and when necessary.

Set 1 Sounds




Set 2 Sounds




Set 3 Sounds

Phonics Groups

Children are placed into groups to suit their needs.

Each group will be focusing on something different depending on the stage the children in the group are at.

Groups are continuously assessed to meet the needs of the children. Children can move groups at any point.

Each groups sessions may differ depending on the needs of the children.

Phonics Screening

- Phonics Screen Year 1
- ▶ In Year 1 all children will take part in the phonics screening. Children need to read 40 words which include real and alien words.
- Children need to score 32 or above to pass the phonics screening.
- All the skills needed are taught during the phonics sessions daily.
- Children have a chance to retake the phonics screen in Year 2 if they do not pass.

At Home

- ► Establish a routine where children can read everyday at home.

- Encourage your child to 'sound out' any unfamiliar words.
