ANGEL WINGS

INGREDIENTS:

250g Flour
5 Egg yolks
2 Tablespoons sour cream
1 Tablespoon sugar
1 Tablespoon vinegar, lemon juice or pure spirit
500g of oil for frying
powdered sugar to sprinkle the angel wings

METHOD:

Mix flour, egg yolks, sour cream, sugar and vinegar together.

Knead the dough until it is as hard as if you were making a dough for dumplings.

Beat it with a rolling-pin so it blisters and leave for 30 minutes.

Roll out the dough thinly and cut into stripes (about 10-12 cm long and 2-3 cm wide).

Cut a small slit in the middle of each stripe, pass one of its sides through it and afterwards pull it through (to make a shape of a twisted ribbon).

Start frying angel wings in hot oil (on each side) until they gain golden colour.

After taking the angel wings out from the oil, place them on the kitchen roll (to drain).

Put them on the plate and sprinkle with powdered sugar (might be mixed with vanilla sugar) .



CRUNCHY LEMON TOP CAKE

INGREDIENTS:

4 oz (100 g) soft margarine
6 oz (175 g) caster sugar
6 oz (179 g) self-raising flour
1 teaspoon of baking powder
2 extra large eggs
4 tablespoons of milk
Finely grated rind of 1 lemon

For the crunchy topping

Juice of a lemon
4 oz (100g) caster or granulated sugar








METHOD:

Pre-heat the oven to 180c /350f /gas4. Lightly grease and base line a 7 in (18 cm) deep round cake tin with greased greaseproof paper. Measure all the ingredients for the cake into a large bowl and beat well for about 2 minutes until smooth and well blended. Turn the mixture into the prepared tin and level the surface.

Bake in the pre-heated oven for about 35-40 minutes or until the cake has shrunk slightly from the sides

MITCHAM LIBRARY TRIP




All the children from Year 1 to Year 6 went on an amazing trip to Mitcham


My proudest moment at Beecholme was getting a B Badge and also making my own video.


