

SCIENCE:

We will be learning about the weather, seasons and shadows. Children will be given the opportunity to carry out exciting scientific experiments.

Maths: The main focus this term is adding and subtracting numbers up to 20. Children will learn how to read and write numbers in words.

Other focus includes:

- Counting objects.
- Comparing numbers using equal, more, greater, less and fewer.
- Ordering numbers and using a number line.
- Finding one more and one less than.



RE: Children will learn about being me in the world.

PSHE: Children will work on being themselves in the world around them (being special and safe).

Computing: Children will explore using key features of computers to enable them to grow in confidence in their use.

ENGLISH:

Writing:

This term, children will be learning how to write simple sentences. Children will learn how to say a sentences before writing it. There will be a focus on sentence structure including, capital letters and full stops, finger space between words, sequencing sentences to form short narratives.

Reading:

All children will have an opportunity to expand on their reading skills and will read with an adult at least once a week. It is important that children bring back their guided reading and library books so they can change them weekly. Bug Club will also be used to support children with their reading.

Phonics:

Daily lessons will be delivered focusing on blended sounds.

REMINDERS:

Reading:

Please try to read the home reading book with your child every day for a minimum of 10 minutes and ask them questions to ensure their understandings. Questions such as, how do you think the character is feeling? What do you think will happen next? Please use reading records to record reading evidence.

Homework:

Homework will be handed out on Fridays and will need to be completed and returned on Mondays. It will include spelling, English and Maths. It will support children in previewing work for the following week.

PE:

P.E. lessons will take place on Mondays and Tuesdays. Please ensure your child brings his/her P.E. kits.

Music:

We will be focusing on singing and rhythm.

Discovery:

This term the children will be learning about where they live. We will be focusing on Mitcham and finding out about Mitcham's past. We will be looking at different types of housing and how it has changed.
