Science: Sound


They will be learning how sound is made by objects vibrating. They will understand how sound travels. They will also learn how musical instruments work and make one for themselves.

Computing: History of computing/ e-safety

We will be learning how the use of computers has changed since the 1950s, and how they can use computers safely?

PE: Weekly lesson with Merton Sports Partnership coach (Wednesday)

They will have a weekly swimming lesson on Tuesday at the Cannons leisure centre.

English: They will study a variety of texts, including: traditional tales and Egyptian Cinderella; Information texts about Ancient Egypt; Egyptian myths and legends; Egyptian shape poetry and calligrams.

Maths: The main topics this term are: a week of inspirational maths; Number and place value: reasoning; Addition and subtraction problem solving; Multiplication and division; and statistics.

PSHE /Values - Being me in my world

They will learn how to help others to feel welcome, and to think of how our school community could be improved.

Music: This term children will learn to play the djembe drums.

RE: Belonging and Identity

They will think about the groups they belong to, and how people show that they belong to a religion. They will consider how new babies are welcomed into families.
