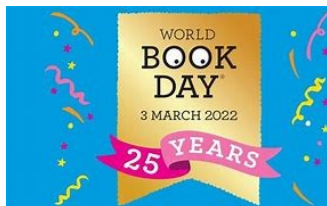




Beecholme Newsletter 4th March, 2022
