School Dinners

We have been informed by Merton that the cost of school dinners will increase from £2.23 to **£2.40 per meal** in September 2022. This is in light of the inflation pressures currently experienced by food suppliers to ensure that the meals provided continue to meet contractual requirements. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are still able to benefit from the Universal Infant Free School Meals grant paid for by the government, as are children who qualify for "free school meals (FSM)". If you are unsure if your child qualifies for FSM, please feel free to call the School Office.
